



BARGAINING UPDATE

Ratification Meeting is the Next Process

Negotiations with Local 1995 and CBRM concluded on February 9, 2012 after 10 days of bargaining.

The Union will now proceed with the ratification process. Your Bargaining Committee is pleased that a tentative collective agreement has been achieved. The tentative agreement is made up of all provisions agreed to, with the wages being determined by binding arbitration. The Bargaining Committee will recommend that the members of Local 1995 vote to accept the tentative agreement. All members of Local 1995 will have an opportunity to vote on the tentative collective agreement in the very near future.

Your Bargaining Committee has been very dedicated to achieving a fair collective agreement for Local 1995 members and thanks you for your continued support. Once the ratification meeting is arranged we will notify you with the details.
